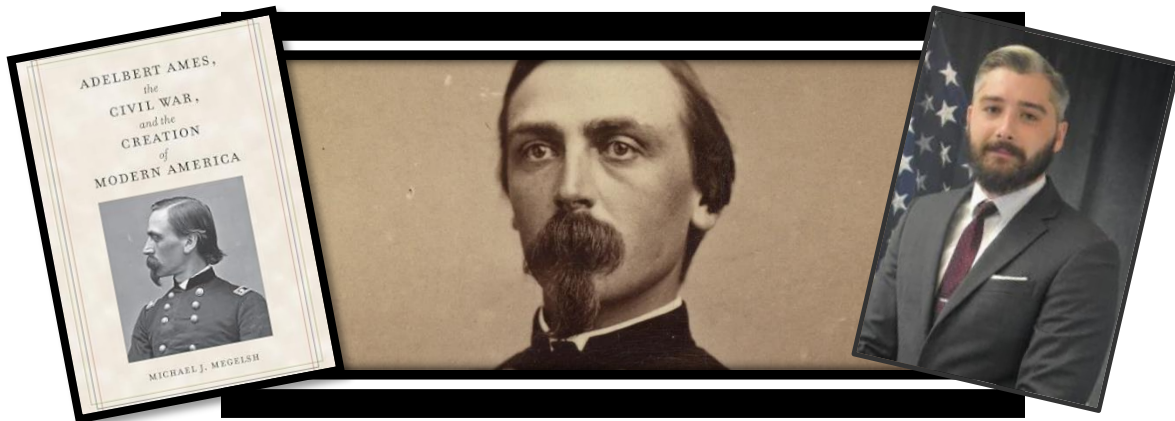

Born on Maine's rocky shore in 1835, Ames, a graduate of the US Military Academy at West Point, served as a Union general during the American Civil War and was heralded as one of the young stars whose leadership was integral in helping the Union to victory. He briefly remained in the army after the conflict, stationed in Mississippi, where he entered the political arena. And that, was merely the beginning...
